Apsys Polska expands its property portfolio

Apsys Polska, a property developer and manager, has acquired a 5,000 sqm property in the centre of Wrocław.

Despite the challenges facing the property market, Apsys Polska continues to pursue its growth strategy. In January this year, the company secured another property, this time in the capital of Lower Silesia.

— We are constantly on the lookout for locations that will allow us to carry out urban development projects in line with the company's strategic objective and our ambition to change cities for the better. Above all, we want all our investments to embody the idea of sustainable cities that are friendly to people and the environment. We see great potential in mixed-use developments that combine residential, retail, office and leisure functions. We see them as an opportunity to develop a new urban model - one that improves the comfort of everyday life for residents, frees them from the constant pressure of time and has a positive impact on work-life balance," says Maciej Wróblewski, Vice President and Development Director at Apsys Polska.

The new investment in Wrocław is perfectly in line with the company's philosophy of creating multidimensional, innovative urban spaces that respond to contemporary needs, support ecological transformation and integrate residents. The acquired property is located in the very centre of the city, next to the Wrocław Market Square, just 5 minutes from the railway station. There are four buildings on the site, including two historic buildings, which will be revitalised and the derelict brownfield site will be upgraded and returned to the city and local community. As part of the high-quality mixed-use development, Apsys plans to create residential lofts, communal urban gardens and services for residents.

– Regeneration projects are Apsys' forte. The best example of this is the realisation of Manufaktura in Łódź, built on the revitalised site of a former factory. The post-industrial space, cut off from the city, has become the new centre of Łódź, a place for shopping, meeting and entertainment, where history, architecture and culture harmoniously combine with modern design and technology to create unique experiences. When we think about development projects, whatever their scale or function, we always put people and their needs first - and this is how we are approaching our next challenge, the Wrocław project. We want it to be a place that is integrated into the life of the city and brings real benefits to its residents," adds Maciej Wróblewski.
